### **Emergency School closures**

The MET office had warned of snowfall over the coming weekend! This prediction now appears to have changed, but we thought this was a good time to remind everyone of the school closure procedure in the event that snow begins to fall during the school day, or if the school has to close first thing in the morning.

Rest assured that neither decision is made lightly and we endeavour to keep the school open as long as is safe and practicable, but our families' and staff's safety is paramount. Being in a rural location, that is often not gritted, does present problems to both families and staff travelling from outside of the village.

If snow has fallen, or is falling heavily before the school day, a text will be sent home to all parents informing them of the decision to either delay the start of the day or close the school. A newsfeed will be placed on the school website bulletin bar and the local radio stations will be informed.

If possible, a local member of staff will man the school gates and put up a sign for any local families who do not receive the message or have already left for their journey to school.

If snow begins to fall *during* the school day and travelling looks likely to be difficult, we will send out a text message to all parents as soon as possible, to request that their children are collected promptly from school. As we have seen in previous years, Cornwall can have very isolated flurries and, whilst the snow may fall heavily and disrupt some parts, it can barely affect others within a very short distance. So please do not delay in responding to the request to collect your child, as the decision will be based on ensuring the safety of **all** our families and staff.

The school will continue to stay in contact via text message and the website bulletin bar with updates and information.


