Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the first Newsletter of the new academic year, it's been such a busy two weeks that it has flown by...

The children have settled into their new classes and have stepped up to the expectations of being in a higher year group very quickly. We continue to be extremely proud of all our children at Veryan and feel very lucky to be able to work with such a wonderful group.

I have been looking at our after school wraparound provision recently and thinking about how we might increase take up. We have decided to trial a reduced price for this term (up until Christmas) to see if this helps. Instead of £4.50 for the hour, the new price will be £3.00 to include a snack.

On 4 of the 5 evenings, there will also be an after school club running which the wraparound group can access if they wish (and if appropriate). The two clubs will be running concurrently but please be aware of the earlier finish for most of the after school clubs and that there will be no snack provided. (timetable on page 2)

Wraparound places need to be booked on Parent Pay as normal.

Please let the office know via phone or email if your child is attending any of the other after school clubs so a list can be made. These are free of charge except for the Y6 club on a Tuesday, when the Y6 group will be running the club for half an hour to raise money for their Y6 trip fund. The cost of this club will be £1 which needs to be paid in cash please on the day.

I realise that there is a lot of information to take in here, so have created a table below to make things a little clearer... I hope it helps!

If you have any questions regarding after school clubs, or anything else, please do not hesitate to contact me and hopefully I can help.

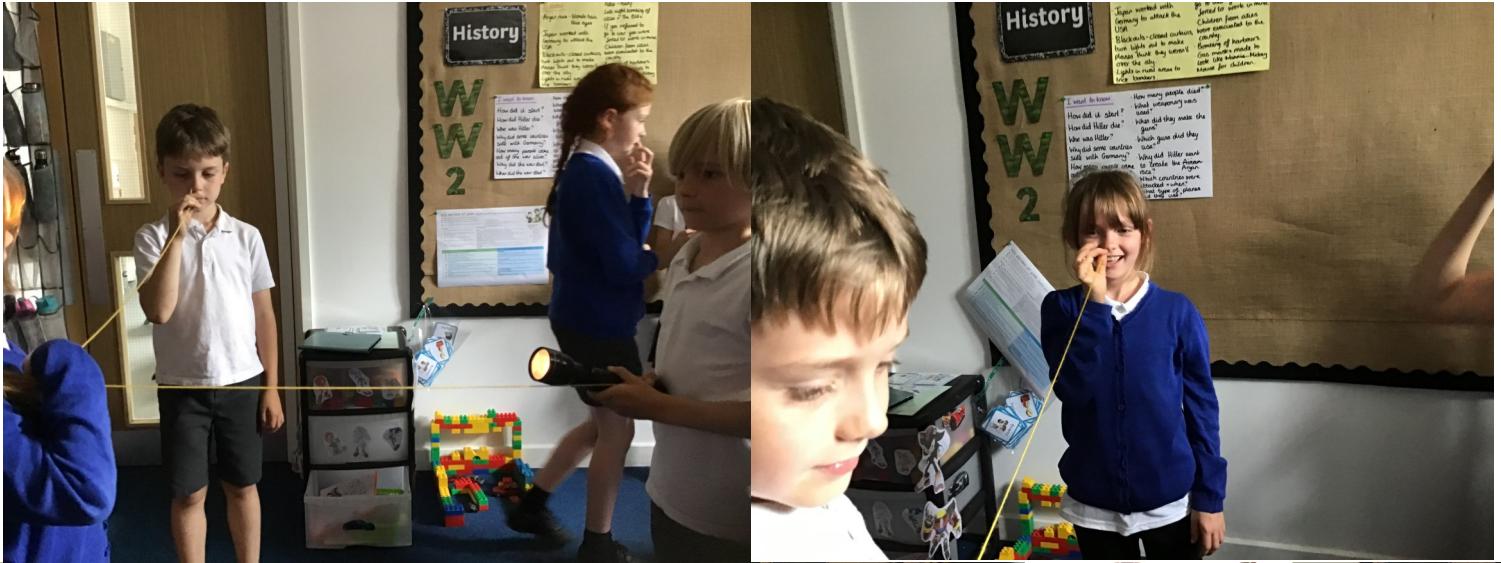
We have been learning about being a scientist by investigating the signs of Autumn

## Free School Meals

If you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals the criteria and link you will need to follow are below. Not only would your child receive free meals but this enables the school to access additional funding. If you would apply by post please contact the office for a paper application form.

### Free school meals eligibility criteria if you receive benefits

A child is eligible for free school meals if their parent/carer (or the child themselves) receives any of the following benefits:

Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).

Income Support (IS)

Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance

Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance

Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190

Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)

Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Supports

If you are claiming the benefits listed below you are not eligible for free school meals. This is regardless of what other benefits/credits are being claimed.

Working Tax Credit

Contribution-Based Job Seeker's Allowance and/or Contribution-Based Employment and Support Allowance
