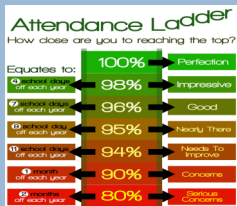

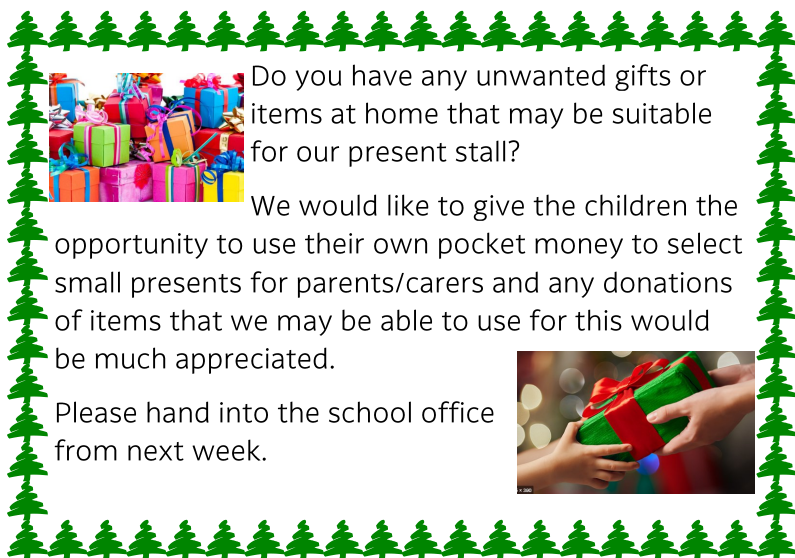

Norovirus

We have been asked to highlight the following to help prevent the spread of Norovirus.

Norovirus causes Gastroenteritis, characterised by sudden onset of vomiting and/or diarrhoea.

Children and staff with symptoms of the Norovirus should:

- Stay away from school until they are free of symptoms for 48 hours & avoid contact with others
- Keep hydrated
- If symptoms persist for more than 48 hrs phone the GP or NHS non-emergency line 111 for advice
- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water regularly, particularly after using the toilet, before eating & handling food.
- Do not attend childcare settings, visit hospitals, residential care homes
- Do not prepare food for others until symptom free for 48 hours
- Use good hygiene in the home, where possible use separate towels and toilets. Clean frequently used surfaces inc door handles, toilet seats with disinfectant.
